## DAY 1 - Welcome to Italy!

Visit the Academy Museum to admire Michelangelo's Statue of David followed with free time for activities like shopping and learning the secrets of traditional Florentine leatherwork. Stop at Piazzale Michelangelo for a scenic picture overlooking Florence. Dinner will be at a local restaurant.

## DAY 6 - San Gimignano - Volterra - Tuscan Countryside



After a comfortable breakfast, relax and ride through unforgettable landscapes composed of gently rolling vine-clad hills before taking a walk in San Gimignano and Volterra (two of the most picturesque of Italy's perfectly preserved medieval towns). Enjoy lunch at an Osteria or dinner at an Agriturismo (farm to table) with Tuscan specialties.

## **DAY 7 - Venice - Burano - Glass Factory**



Leave Tuscany for a drive through the Apennine Mountains to reach Venice. Enter a glittering maze of islands, canals, and bridges on a lagoon cruise to the colorful Island of Burano where traditional fishing boats are still used. Enjoy lunch with some free time on the island before returning to Venice for a walking tour of St. Marks' Square, Byzantine Basilica, Doge's Palace, Bridge of Sighs, and the local Glass Factory. Hotel: Belstay, Voco or similar (1 night).

## **DAY 8 - Venice - Gubbio**



This morning, enjoy Venice at your own pace with time for shopping or a gondola ride. In the afternoon, say "ciao" to Venice and enjoy a scenic drive through the wild Apennine Mountains towards the stone-built hill town of Gubbio. In the afternoon, reach our hotel in the Piedmont region where we will spend the next three nights. Dinner will be served in the hotel's restaurant. Hotel: Belstay Roma Aurelia or similar (3 nights).

## DAY 6 - Asti



Enjoy some free time in Asti city center for shopping. In the afternoon, drive through the area of Asti to reach a local winery where sweet Moscato grapes grow and are transformed into Asti Spumante. Right around the corner is where Brachetto and Barbera grapes come from. Tonight, dinner will be served at a local restaurant.

# DAY 7 - Northwest Area "Piedmont"



Experience some pearls of the beautiful region of Piedmont. The most common grape variety from Piedmont is Nebbiolo, known in this region since the 13th century. Barolo, Barbaresco, and many other wines are created from this variety. After a visit to the local winery lunch will be served at the local restaurant. Tonight is a free evening to enjoy at leisure.

# DAY 8 - Tuscany & the Chianti Hills



Leave the region of Piemonte for the beautiful Chianti area in the heart of Tuscany. Visit some small villages with free time to frequent some wine shops and taste local wine and food. In the late afternoon, take a short ride to our hotel where you are sure to be amazed by an authentic Tuscan dinner. **Hotel: CDH Radda, Tenuta di Ricavo, or similar (3 nights)**

Afterwards, go to the small village of Pienza to discover its delicious cheeses which pair perfectly with wine. Two important Tuscan red wines grow in this area. Brunello Di Montalcino is a strong red wine made exclusively of Brunello grapes which has a long life (the first official great vintage was in 1888 and 5 perfectly intact bottles have been kept). Vino Nobile Di Montepulciano is made from Prugnolo Gentile grapes, this wine is strong and sour when young and becomes increasingly smooth and spicy with age.

# **DAY 11 - From Tuscany to the Roman Castles**



Leave Tuscany for the Roman Castles (a group of villages southeast of Rome where the Pope spends his summers) to visit a local winery. Here the varieties of white grapes are cultivated as Bellone, Arciprete white (a Bellone biotype), and two varieties of Greek grapes, called Moro and Yellow (which had almost disappeared in the territory until they were recently revalued). In the afternoon, check into the hotel. Tonight, dinner will be served at a local restaurant to celebrate the success of our Great Wines of Italy tour. Hotel: Benito al Bosco, Castel Vecchio or similar (1 night)



### THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLY TO 2024/2025 VACATIONS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The purchase of any travel services offered by Great Tours of Italy.com (G.T.I.) constitutes a contractual arrangement between you and G.T.I. and represents your acceptance of the G.T.I. Terms & Conditions set out herein. Please ensure that you read carefully and understand these Terms & Conditions prior to booking.

### RESERVATION AND FINAL PAYMENT

A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of USD 400 or CAD 450 or AUD 450 or NZD 450 per land vacation per person is required for G.T.I. (30% for Customized Tour/Services) to reserve space for you. Your booking is not confirmed until the deposit is received by G.T.I. and you receive a confirmation invoice. G.T.I accepts wire transfer, Visa, Master Card, Discover, and American Express. Your reservation will be automatically canceled if deposit is not received by G.T.I. by the deposit due date. On certain departures, deposits may be required at time of booking to hold or to confirm space for you. Please review and verify your booking invoice thoroughly and contact G.T.I. immediately if your invoice appears to be incorrect or incomplete, as it may not be possible to make changes later. G.T.I. cannot accept responsibility if we are not notified of inaccuracies within 5 days of sending out the invoice. ### LAST MINUTE

Reservations made 30 days or less prior to departure will be subject to a \$150 fee. All reservations must be made no later than 5 days prior to departure.
